A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, TEMPORARILY DEFERRING REQUIRED BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT PAYMENT AND PENALTIES FOR LATE PAYMENT OF BUSINESS TAX RECEIPTS FOR ALL EXISTING BUSINESSES THROUGH JANUARY 31, 2021; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, due to the financial burdens stemming from the Coronavirus crisis, to help ease the financial burdens caused by COVID-19 the City proposes to temporarily defer the annual Business Tax Receipt payment of existing businesses; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO

SECTION 1. That the City Commission approves the temporary deferral of collecting late payments on Business Tax Receipts for existing businesses through January 31, 2021.

SECTION 2. That city staff is hereby directed to maintain the status of Business Tax Receipt as active for approved businesses through January 31, 2021.

SECTION 3. That city staff is hereby directed to defer calculating and applying the fees outlined in § 113.27, Late Payment, (of the Business Tax Receipt Regulations) for existing and approved businesses through January 31, 2021.

SECTION 4. That Late Payment schedule, as outlined in § 113.27 (of the Business Tax Receipt Regulations) shall be applied as follows, starting on February 1, 2021: Business tax receipts not renewed by January 31, 2021, shall be considered delinquent unless the tax is due and payable on or before the first working day following January 31, 2021. Payment received after

January 31, 2021, requires a delinquency fee consisting of a 10% penalty with an additional 5% penalty for each succeeding month. The postmark date shall be the determining factor.

SECTION 5. That Late Payment schedule, as outlined in § 113.27 (D) (of the Business Tax Receipt Regulations) shall be applied, starting on July 1, 2021.
