Horacio Danovich, CIP & Innovative District Director, presented the item and stated that there are no changes from the first reading.

Mr. Danovich introduced two members of his team, Dominique Mitchell, Assistant, and Fernand Thony who will be handling six of the projects presented. The third member of his team, Filio Tsapakis will be introduced at a later time.

Mayor Hardin stated that this is a tremendous step forward with the General Obligation (G.O.) Bond projects, which were overwhelmingly voted on positively by the residents, and this is moving a lot of these items forward

in the process. Therefore, the steps being taken at this meeting will lead to a lot of good things for the City of Pompano Beach.
