Summary Explanation/Background:

Chapter 91 section 91.10 (c) of the Code of Ordinances does not currently permit perpendicular docking of small personal watercraft (wave-runners) and this has proven to be challenging for residents where parallel docking can be very difficult and at times dangerous. As a result, the Marina Advisory Board along with Engineering is recommending to amend our Code in order to:

- 1) Allow the perpendicular docking of small personal watercraft.
- 2) Restrict the size limitation of the small personal watercraft to 13 feet.
- 3) Restrict the number of small personal watercraft that can be stored/docked on the platform at a residential lot to four.
