Adoption of tentative budget for the Emergency Medical Services District for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 totaling \$19,864,495.

Summary Explanation/Background:

Pursuant to State Statute 200.065, taxing authorities are required to adopt Fiscal Year tentative and final millage rates and the citywide budget following the first and the final public hearings. At the public hearings, the rolled-back rate, percentage of increase over the rolled-back rate, and the millage rate to be levied must be publicly read.
