Summary Explanation/Background:

Bid E-37-17 was issued to establish a contract for the installation of a new reuse water main system. The project location is from N.E. 16th Street and 24th Avenue in Pompano Beach, to N.E. 27th Street in Lighthouse Point. The Bid award is recommended to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, DBF Construction, LLC, in the amount of \$1,735,001.00. The General Services Department performed outreach to Pompano Beach drainage and underground utility firms to inform them about this project. A total of thirty-six (36) local companies were notified. This solicitation was assigned a voluntary 15% Local Business participation goal and a 15% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal; the recommended firm is a Local Pompano Beach Business that has indicated 19.85% SBE participation. City Commission approval of the contract award is requested.
