### Summary Explanation/Background:

The Additional Local Option Gas Tax - this is the first three cents of the Five Cent Local Option Gas Tax. The County retains 48.73%; the remaining 51.27% is distributed back to the Cities based on population. The City's share is deposited in the CIP (Fund 302) and is used for transportation related capital improvements.

**Origin of request for this action:** Broward County

**Fiscal impact and source of funding:** Distributions are deposited into the Capital Improvement Fund 302.
