Summary Explanation/Background:

To provide professional engineering and surveying services for proposed drainage improvements in the US1 & NE 14th Street Causeway area referenced as Study Area #8 in the City's 2013 Stormwater Master Plan. The consultant will evaluate options for providing drainage improvements, identify flood prone areas, and address water quality treatment solutions within the project limits. The proposed alternatives will examine the feasibility of exfiltration trench, improved pipe conveyance and swale improvements. Services include the preparation of construction plans and specifications including surveying, utility locates services, utility test holes, geotechnical engineering services, engineering design, and permitting.
