Summary Explanation/Background:

This agreement will allow an 87.5% reimbursement to the City of Pompano Beach with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) cost share being 75% and the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management cost share being 12.5%. The City incurred an estimated \$55,516.44 in qualifying dollars for reimbursement with an estimated cost share of \$6,940.
