AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR CAPACITY ALLOCATION IN PHASE 1 OF THE C-51 RESERVOIR BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH AND PALM BEACH AGGREGATES, LLC; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**Summary Explanation/Background:**

We have a "One Water" concept using wells, reuse and stormwater, that makes up our current integrated water supply approach. Water from the C-51 would add diversification to our sustainable water supply, one that would not be affected by sea level rise, which is a threat to our eastern wells. I recommend that the City purchase 2 MGD from the C-51 reservoir project. This would diversify the City's approach to future water supply and support Strategic Plan Goal 4 for Superior Capacity for Growth through Sustainability of the City's water resources.
