A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH AND DANIA PIER MANAGEMENT CORP. TO OPERATE A BAIT AND TACKLE SHOP AT THE CITY'S PIER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Fiscal Impact: The City will receive revenue of \$66,000 yearly.)

Summary Explanation/Background:

The license agreement is with Dania Pier Management Corp. to operate a bait and tackle shop at the City's Pier located at 222 North Pompano Beach Boulevard. The term of the agreement is for five years, with no renewal options. The licensee shall retain all monies from entrance fees and the sale of miscellaneous concession items. The licensee shall pay the City a fixed annual payment of \$66,000, which will be paid in monthly installments of \$5,500 on the first day of each month.
