AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 100, "STREETS AND SIDEWALKS," OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING SECTION 100.35, "BUILDING OR OBSTRUCTION ON PUBLIC STREETS, SIDEWALKS, AND RIGHT-OF-WAY SWALE AREAS; PEDESTRIAN MEDIAN SAFETY," TO DELETE INCONSISTENT LANGUAGE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Summary Explanation/Background:

Ordinance No. 2020-59, passed on June 24, 2020 contained language that was inadvertently left in the Ordinance after another corresponding Ordinance regulating pedestrian right-of-way vendors was amended, creating a conflict between the two code sections. This Ordinance corrects the scrivener's error by removing subsection (C)(2) of Section 100.35, "Building or Obstruction on Public Streets, Sidewalks, and Right-of-Way Swale Areas; Pedestrian Median Safety."
