All members on the Pompano Beach Board should be residents of the City of Pompano Beach, *unless* the Board is unable to obtain a qualified resident from the City- whereupon the Commission by majority vote may appoint a non-resident.

It is clear that the nominees for positions on the Unsafe Structures Board should only be those that meet the specified occupations. The only variable may be resident/non-resident.
